- Between the International Media Centre and the Lisieux train station on 27 May
- Between the Accreditation Centre and the International Media Centre, upon presentation of an accreditation badge, every 30 minutes during the Accreditation Centre opening hours
- Between the accommodation venues of the media and the International Media Centre, upon presentation of an accreditation badge
