



The G7 Summit under French Presidency will take place from 24 to 26 August 2019 in Biarritz, in the Pyrénées-Atlantiques Department of the Nouvelle-Aquitaine Region.

An International Press Centre will be open from **Friday, 23 August from midday until Monday evening, 26 August.**

It will be located in **Halle d'Iraty** (*Rue de Pitchot, 64200 Biarritz*), 300 metres from the international airport, 1 kilometre from the train station, 2 kilometres from the A63 motorway, and 4 kilometres from the Summit's meeting venues. Transport will be provided to facilitate travel between the city centre and Halle d'Iraty during the Summit.

The Summit's accreditation procedure is now closed.

1. Accommodation:

We suggest that you book your accommodation now. Regarding the number of nights, we would like to draw your attention to the information regarding airport and station closures below.

- Biarritz airport will be closed to the public from Thursday, 22 August at 23:59 until Monday, 26 August inclusive.
- Biarritz train station will be closed from Friday, 23 August at 23:59 until Monday, 26 August inclusive.
